

## **Behavior Management Plan**

My goal is to help all students have a successful school year. In order to do so, I will work hard to support my students and provide a positive educational climate. I know that together we can make it happen. The plan below outlines our classroom rules, positive recognition for appropriate behavior, and consequences for inappropriate behavior. They are:

- RULES:**
1. RESPECT OTHERS (their person, property, and right to be different).
  2. COME TO CLASS WITH MATERIALS AND POSITIVE LEARNING ATTITUDE.
  3. BE ATTENTIVE AND ON TASK.
  4. BE ON TIME TO CLASS.
  5. PICKUP AFTER YOURSELF.
  6. RAISE YOUR HAND.

**Positive Recognition:** To encourage students to follow the rules, I will recognize appropriate behavior with praise, grades, and positive notes home.

**Consequences:** If a student chooses to break a rule, however, the following steps will be taken:

First time: Warning.

Second time: Warning and stay after bell to discuss behavior.

Third time: Noontime detention.

Fourth time: After school detention and parents are notified.

Fifth time: Sent to administration and placed on a behavior contract.

**\*\*\* Severe behavior such as fighting or insubordination will result in immediate removal from class.**
